RULES AND BYELAWS

The following Rules and Byelaws, made by the Council under Article 69 of the Articles of Association, were adopted at the Annual General Meeting of the Ipswich Maritime Trust held on 1st December 2004 (background reference see Council Meeting minutes for 16/06/2004 & 15/09/2004).

1. Admission as a Member

1.1 The Council may at any meeting decide to admit a person to membership of the company if:

1. that person meets and conditions of membership they have received from that person;
2. an application containing a statement that the applicant consents to becoming a member and promises to abide by the rules of the company;

2. Conditions of Membership

2.1 A person will remain as a member for as long as they meet the following conditions:

1. they have paid any membership fee due from that member within six weeks of it becoming due;
2. they have not done or failed to do any act which in the opinion of the Council brings the company into disrepute.

3. Termination of Membership

3.1 A member's membership will automatically lapse if:

1. they fail to pay any membership fee due from that member within six weeks of it becoming due;
2. the Council may terminate any person's membership if they fail to meet the conditions of membership.

3.2 A member may resign at any time by written notice to the company (but such resignation shall not have effect if it would mean that there would be fewer than one member).

4. Membership fee

4.1 The Council shall fix the membership fees from time to time. The Council may set different fees for different types of membership. In setting the membership fees the Council may not discriminate unlawfully

5. Changing these Rules and Byelaws

5.1 These Rules and Byelaws may be changed by the Council at any time with immediate affect.
